YOUTH Volunteer Positions

Den Chief (Age 14+, Rank 1st Class or above)

- Assist Den Leaders in ensuring that campers get to activity stations in a timely manner and participate appropriately in camp activities.
- Take Cub Scouts to the restroom ensuring that the Buddy System is followed and that restroom is clear of all adults before Cub Scouts enter.
- Work with Den Leaders to keep all camp areas clean and safe.
- Evaluate staff and day camp program to make recommendations for next year's camp.

Youth Program Staff (Age 14+) Games, Sports, Crafts, Scout Skills, Skit/Song, Nature/Outdoor, etc.

- Set-up, Break-down Program Area with Program Leader.
- Work with Program Director to understand the program and how each activity is done
- Under supervision of adult staff, present program to campers referring to Program Leader for help when needed.
- Supervise the campers at activity area, report to Program Area Leader any repairs or replacement as needed.
- Evaluate staff and day camp program to make recommendations for next year's camp.

Sibling Assistant (Age 14+)

- Assist Sibling Leader in carrying out age-appropriate curriculum and ensure campers participate appropriately in camp activities.
- Oversee sunscreen, insect repellent, and hand sanitizer use as well as proper fluid intake.
- See that standards for leadership, program activities, health and safety are maintained.
- Work with other staff members to keep all camp areas clean and safe.
- Evaluate staff and day camp program to make recommendations for next year's camp.

Camp Aid (Age 11-14) volunteer ONLY on days the parent/guardian is volunteering

- Assist Adult Staff in various duties including: den programs, activity areas, replenishing activity area materials, snack sorting and distribution, camp headquarters administration, etc.

The first interest of every staff member is CAMPER. The camp exists and operates for them. In Scouting, we deal through volunteer leaders, and the camp staff supplements them, taking from their shoulders the burden of tedious administrative details, strengthening their leadership and supporting them in their dealings with the Scouts and other children.

Scout will be required to wear the official Boy Scout Class B from their Troop as prescribed by the Camp Director. The staff member will wear the uniform while on duty. Neatness and cleanliness in person is a fundamental obligation.

A staff member's personal conduct both in and out of camp that may interfere with camp morale or undesirably influence the opinion of the camp neighbors renders the staff member useless for further service.
